Art!

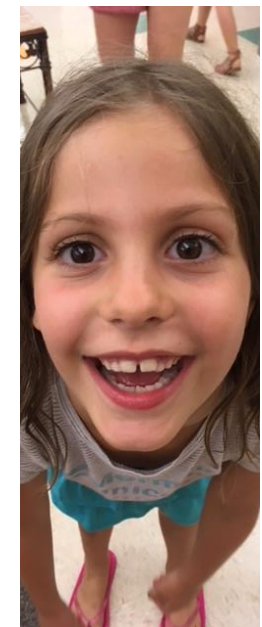
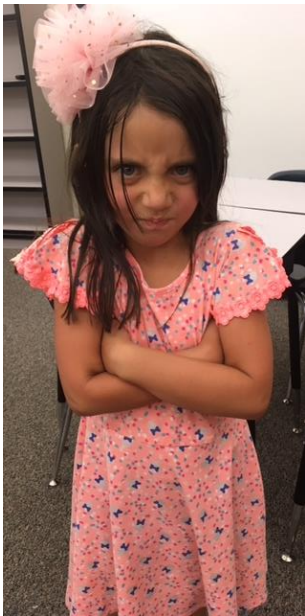
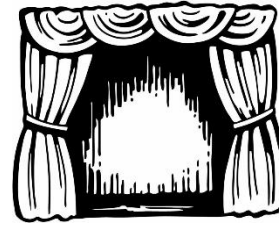
