





Owl Pellets: A Spooky Science Investigation

Last month our staff's curriculum focused on adding science into the spooky month of October. Nicole's club allowed the kids to investigate owl pellets by dissecting them and analyzing their pieces for organic material and bones! They used toothpicks, tweezers, and magnifying glasses to determine what they found and documented their findings in a field journal. They used a guide to help them figure out what bones they were able to find, and learned the scientific names for them.
