Last month was full of new and interesting experiences all created and led by our community of kids. Here are some fun things that had to be shared!

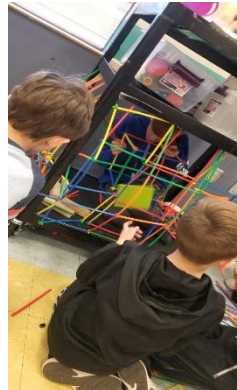
Story Time with Mermaid Marek
