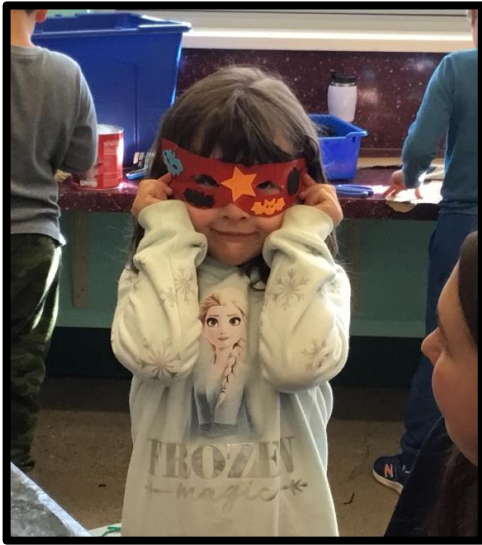


Donations Rock! - Thank you to our generous families for the donations of recyclables and d.i.y supplies we have been receiving. We are still accepting:
