Q: Why do you think Picasso decided to use cubism to make his art?

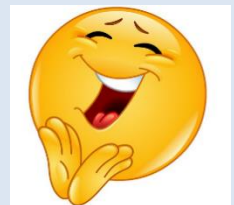
Cosana: So it could look weird.
