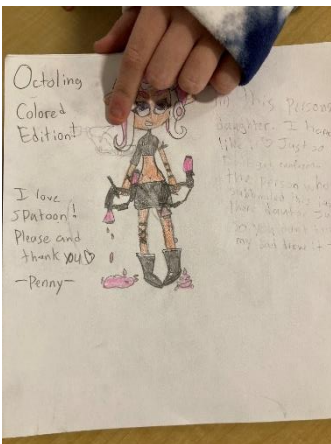

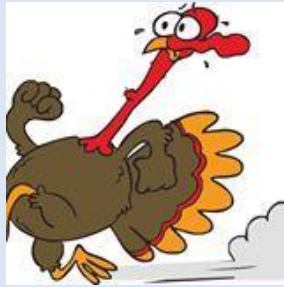


Penny (pictured above) with some of her latest pieces.
