Health & Safety Reminders:

As we get into the New Year and come back from the holidays, here are some reminders of our COVID-safe practices.

When dropping off, please have your child remain in their seat until they are screened.

Everyone in the vehicle should be wearing a mask.

Please take off hats so that the screener may take their temperature.

Have child sit still so that we can get a good reading. The cold weather does not make it easy with our no-touch thermometers.

Screeners will have masks, gloves and protective eyewear when screening.

Hand sanitizer is administered frequently, including upon entry and exiting of the program.

Tables, seating, and materials are disinfected between uses.

Groups are not combined and use separate play structures daily.

If a third party comes to the playground (which is not allowed and when it happens, we ask them to leave), we disinfect the structure before our students may play on the playground.

Bria said she wants to be nicer to her family.


Andrew wants to use his wish for more Dragoman, but admits it should be to say less bad words.
