-Please make sure kids have their necessary school supplies each day, including laptop/tablet and chargers. Daily Schedules are also very helpful for us to keep up!

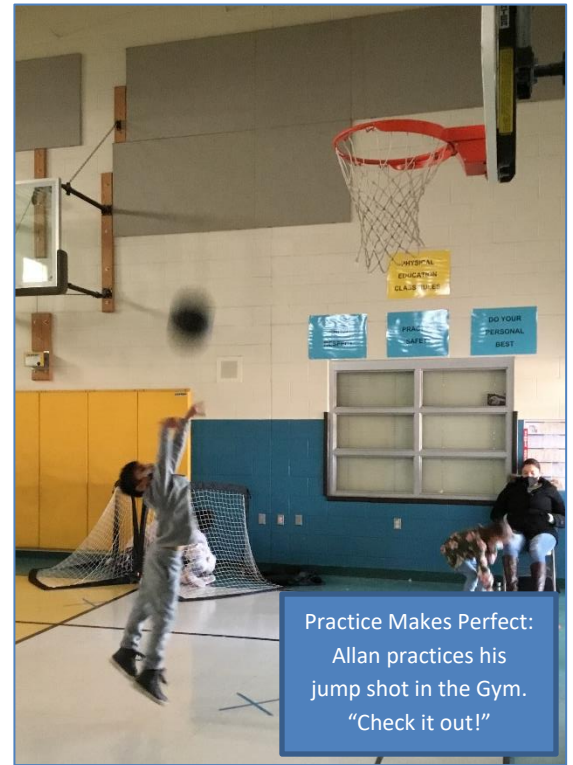
-For Drop-Off/Pick-Up, please wear a mask and stay inside your vehicle. This is for your safety and ours.

Practice Makes Perfect: Allan practices his jump shot in the Gym. "Check it out!"

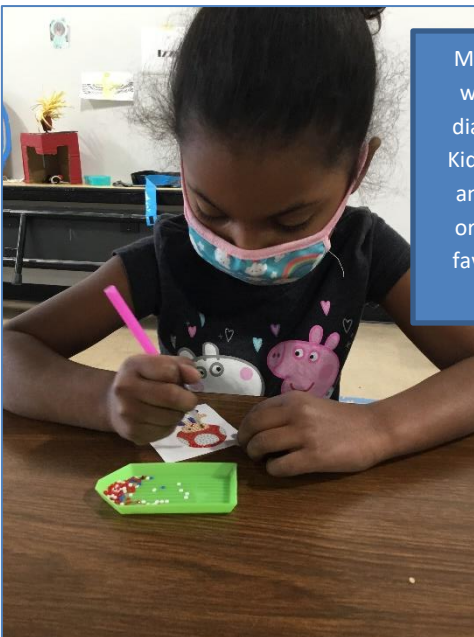
Cafeteria Pod
