


News from North Star Summer Camp


As we moved on to different pattern concepts we were introduced to the artist Yayoi Kusama. Kusama is famous for her interactive and family friendly exhibition called the "Obliteration Room." Yayoi Kusama's interactive Obliteration Room begins as a white space which visitors are invited to cover with stickers. Over the course of a few weeks the room is transformed from a blank canvas into an explosion of color, with thousands of spots stuck on every available surface. We wondered how we could create our own Obliteration Room in the cafeteria. Cabin 5 helped create a space that could be covered in dots. We covered the walls with yellow butcher paper. Each cabin was given sheets of sticker dots with the instruction to place them anywhere they wanted within the boundaries. Over the course of a few hours we saw the space transform into a piece of it that you could walk into.
