Kids are encouraged to bring a personal **water bottle** from home.

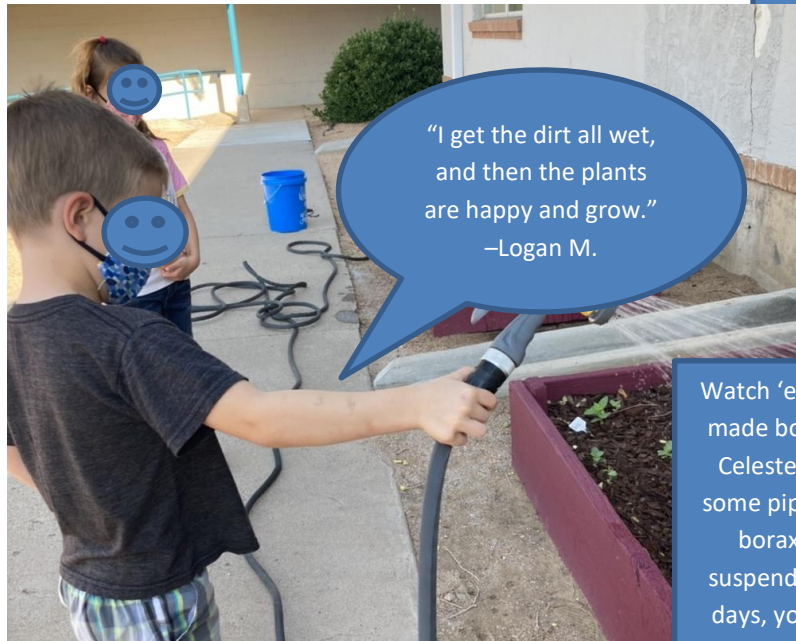
Kids will be getting wet for Water Play every Tuesday and Thursday. Please pack a **towel and extra set of clothes**.

Sombra Squad Summer Stories



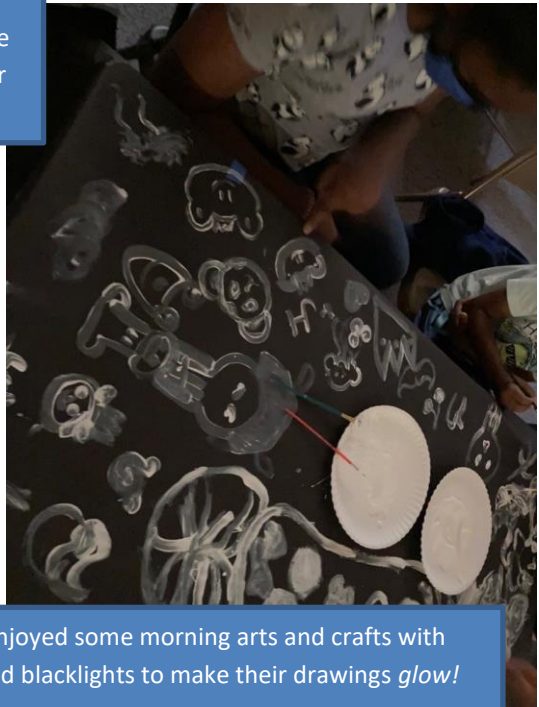

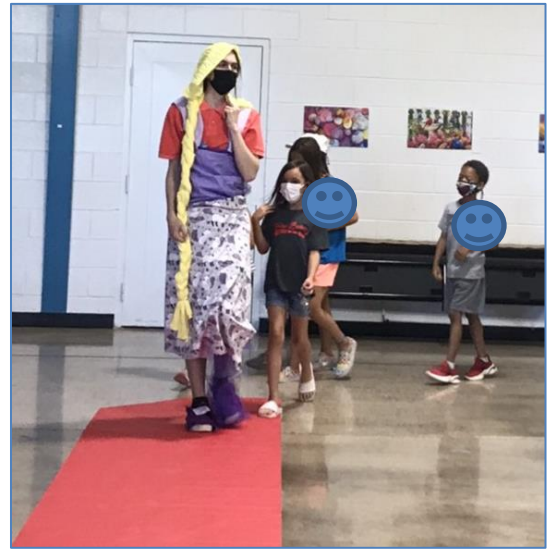


Glow-in-the-Dark Paint: The kids enjoyed some morning arts and crafts with Sommer. They used special paint and blacklights to make their drawings *glow*!
