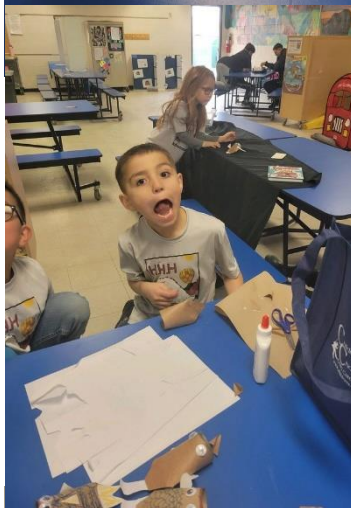

So, to brighten up our afternoon and our "fish tanks," we decided to make some fishy friends of our own. By making our own fish, we could decide on the colors and designs!

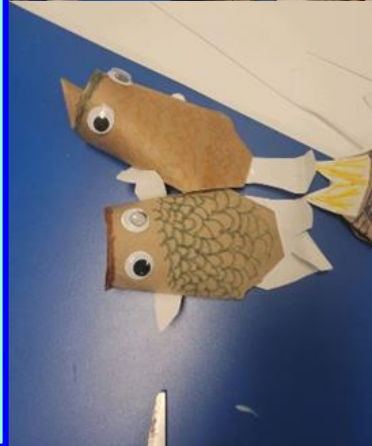
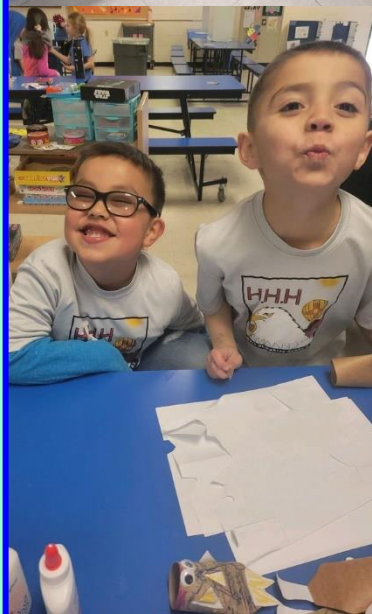


While enjoying our creativity and fish making skills, we also explored our fishy face imitation abilities!

## Here is what you will need:

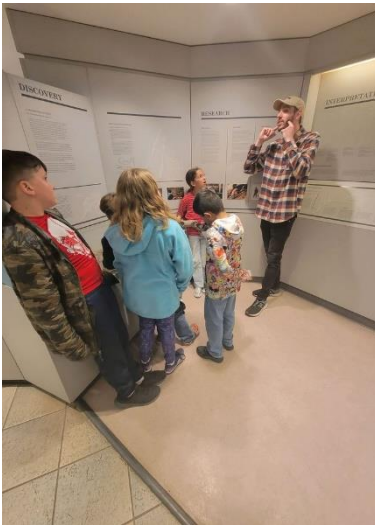
- Balloons (white make for easier decorating)
