















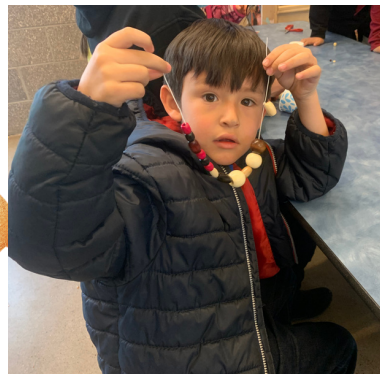
Older Kids Learning Real Life Skills

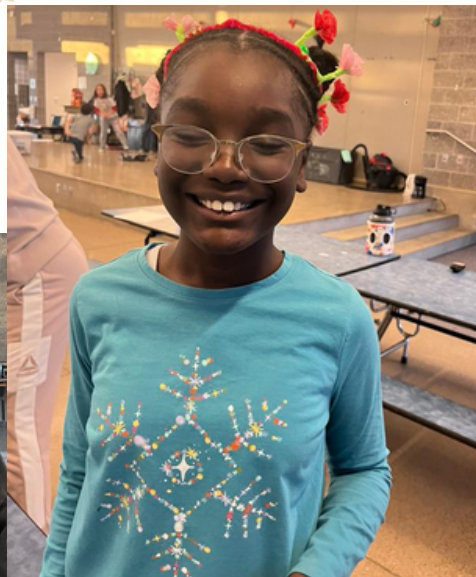


Wednesday Gym Days

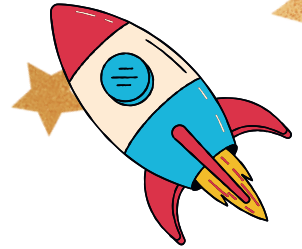
Flower Crowns!
