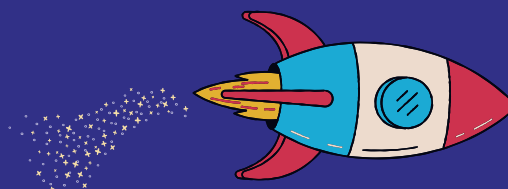

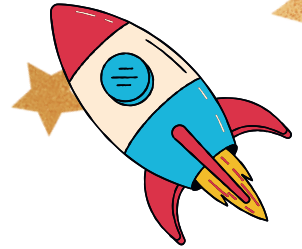
## Team Cleanup
