We went off into nature to find loose parts to create our portraits with. We talked about what pieces of nature would work best to create different parts of our face and head. 

I would say either the greatest youtuber or engineer because they are really fun and you can learn stuff off of them. I have this paper airplane I made off of it, it's called "The flame"!


