It is important that you remember to bring your picture identification when is picking up your child. We have new staff as well as substitute staff occasionally coming from other Children's Choice sites . It would be appreciated if you remain patient if/when you are asked to show ID even if you've picked up your child before. It is essential in training new staff who are not familiar with parents AND in ensuring that all kids are safe and accounted for.

<u>All parents</u> who require our child care services in the mornings <u>MUST sign</u> <u>in their children</u> if they are present before 7:50AM. If a child is not registered/signed in with Chldren's Choice, they will be directed to go to the front office until 7:50AM when an active duty is outside to supervise all children of Inez Elementary.

That being said, when you pick up your child, please **SIGN THEM OUT.** If you do not sign out your child on our iPad, <u>you will be charged</u> an additional fee of \$1 per minute after 6pm.

Additionally, every other **FRIDAY** we will be placing all items in the **lost and found bin** onto tables for children and their guardians to look through and find. The following week <u>we will be giving ALL items left in the lost and</u> <u>found bin to charity</u>. If you know your child is missing a jacket, water bottle, lunchbox, etc, please look through the lost and found bin!
