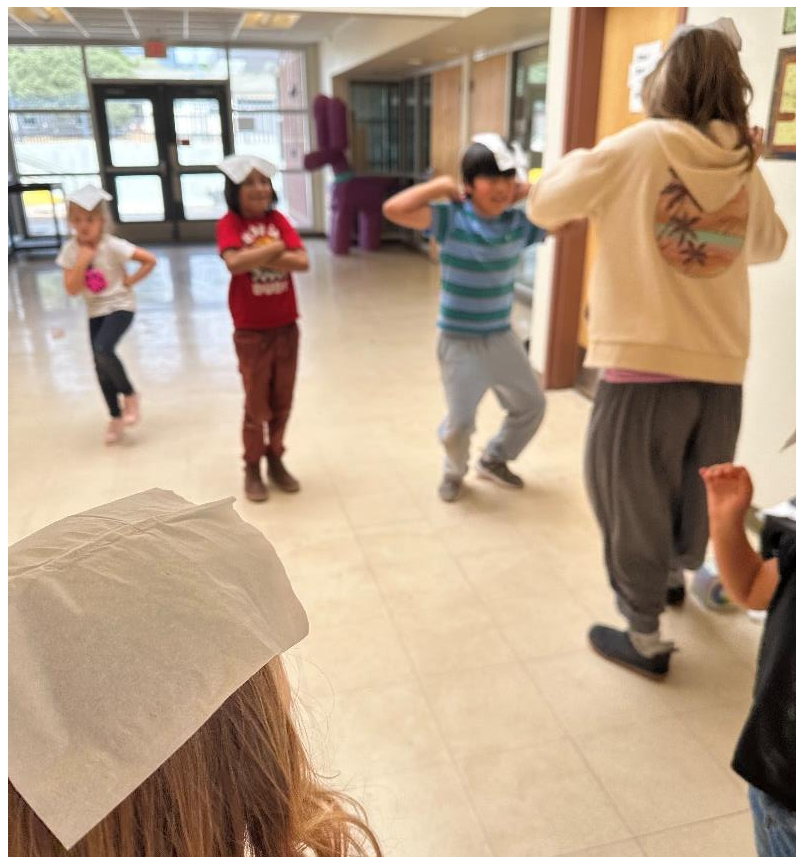
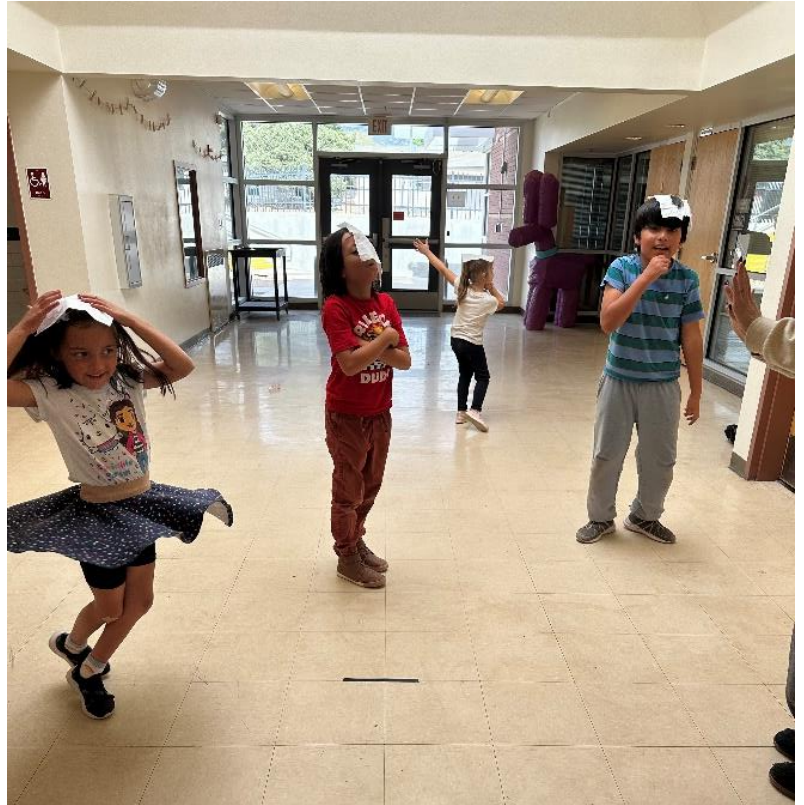
Tissue Dancing with Ariel
