-The lost & found will be donated at the end of the school year, so come dig through it before it's gone!

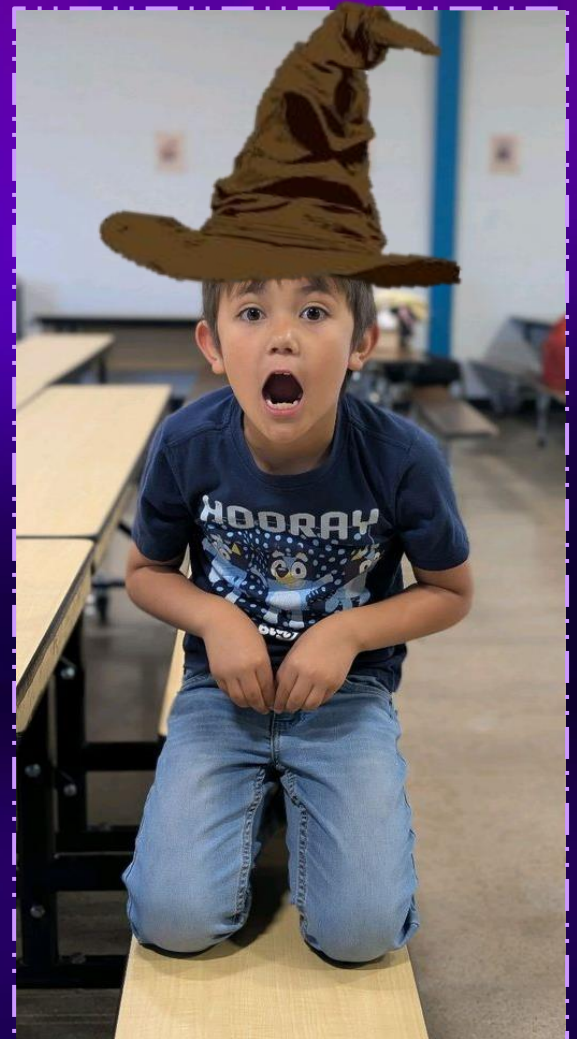
- Children's Choice will be **CLOSED** Monday the 26th and Friday the 30th! Come and say good bye on Thursday, even if you aren't attending CC that day!
