






Yer a Wizard, Wilbur Wright!

Hello, my name is Wilbur Wright. You probably know me and my brother Orville best as the ones built the world's first airplane. I was born on April 16, 1867. My mom's name was Susan and my dad's name was Milton Wright. He worked as a bishop and I was one of 6 kids in my family. When I was 11 years old, I received a small helicopter toy from my father which inspired me to want to fly and to build a flying machine. I wanted to be the first to fly. In 1884, my brother Orville and I started a printing business and then 8 years later we opened a bike shop. I became a mechanic and worked with my brother in a bicycle shop. I am best known for inventing and building and flying the world's first successful airplane with my brother Orville.

After several years of working on ideas for our first plane, and creating 3 full-sized gliders, we built the powered and controlled plane called the Wright Flyer in Kitty Hawk, North Carolina on December 17, 1903. In 1906, we received a patent for our airplane invention. Something that you may not know about me is that my first airplane was made out of wing spars and ash wood. Sadly, I died on May 30, 1912 from typhoid fever at age 45. A quote to remember me is, "It is possible to fly without motors, but not without knowledge and skill".
