

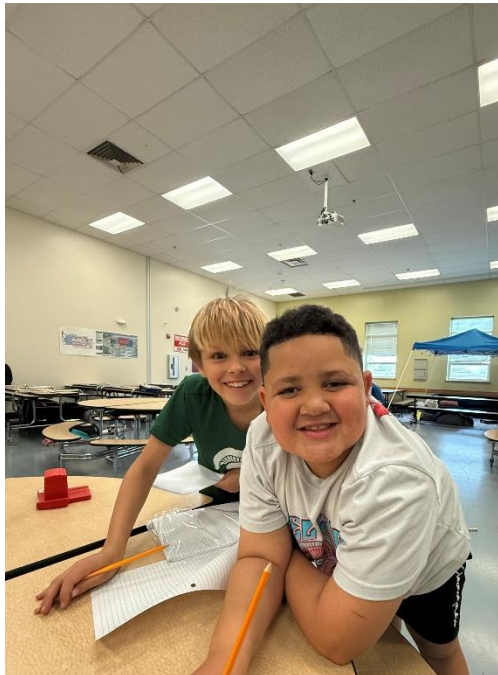


## JB News – Kid Interviews!
