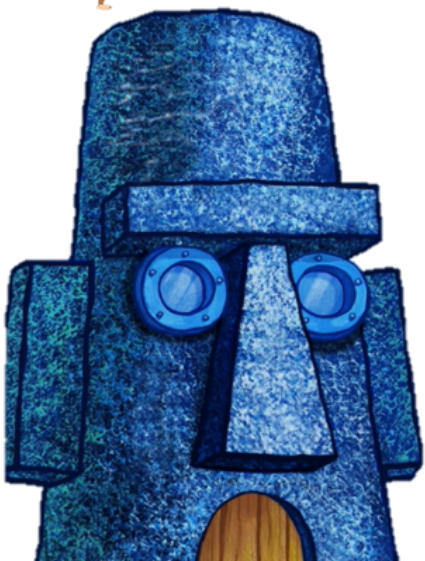

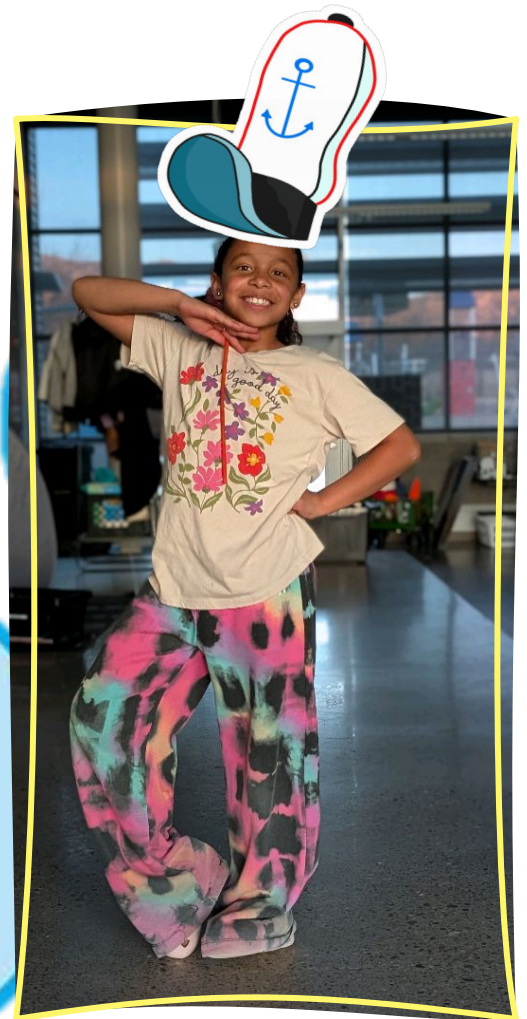
## HI, MERIYAH!

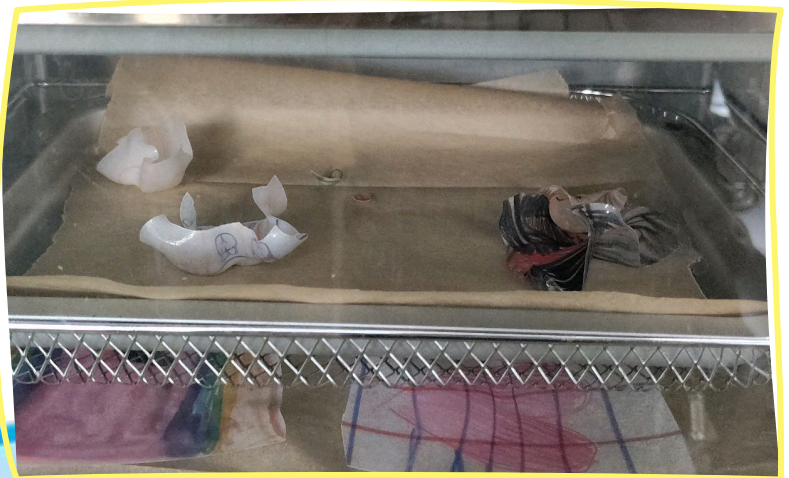
seeing value and hues of colors being used and how they change when they shrink, and so much more!

"I heard at Papa Murphy's, they let you make it yourself." Leonardo, 11

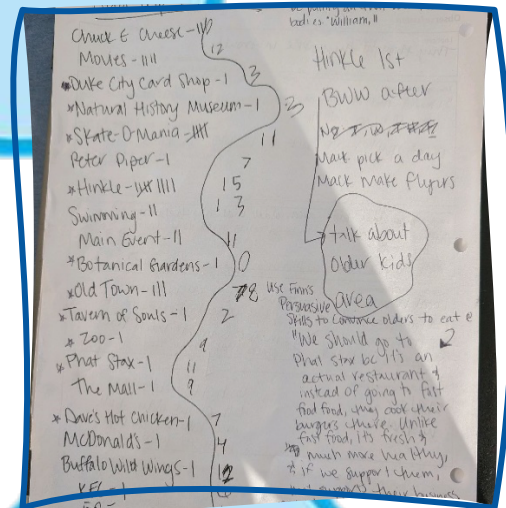
Now the older kids started really thinking about what food they wanted to eat and why.
