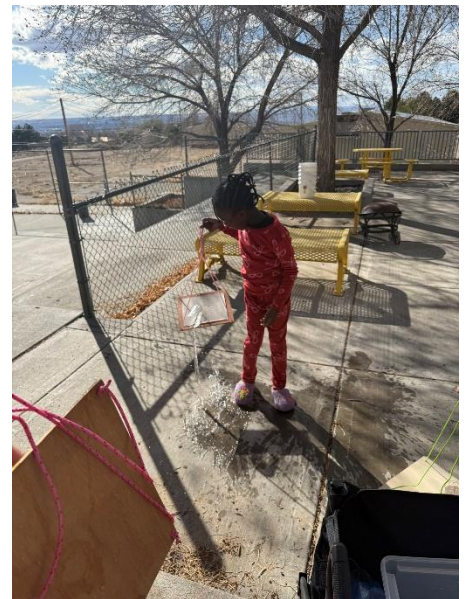

Kids learned that inertia is the tendency of an object to stay still or keep moving unless something else interferes. As we experimented, we tested different ways to make objects move, stop, and change direction, discovering what worked and what didn't along the way. There were lots of moments of problem-solving, laughter, water splashing everywhere and perseverance as we adjusted our ideas and tried again.
