Our 5th graders brought history to life at their Living Wax Museum! Staff explored the room, pressing buttons to see each "statue" come alive and share their story.

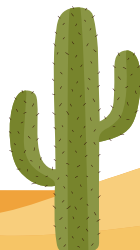
Piper stood out as Alice Paul, Ben impressed as Michael Collins, and Annette shined as Amelia Earhart—just a few of the many amazing figures represented.

Next, the kids will bring their collections to life by painting their rocks with bright colors and designs. We can't wait to see their creativity shine!





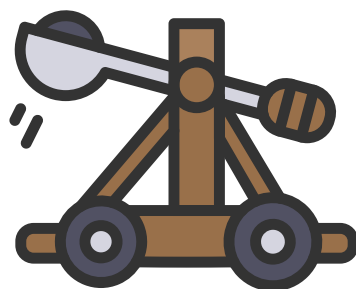
