With very little adult assistance, they produced a creative, silly, and surprisingly informative video that showcases both their teamwork and imagination.

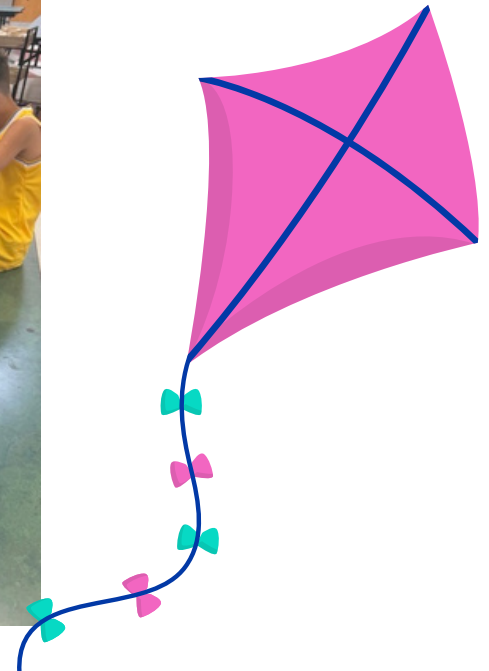
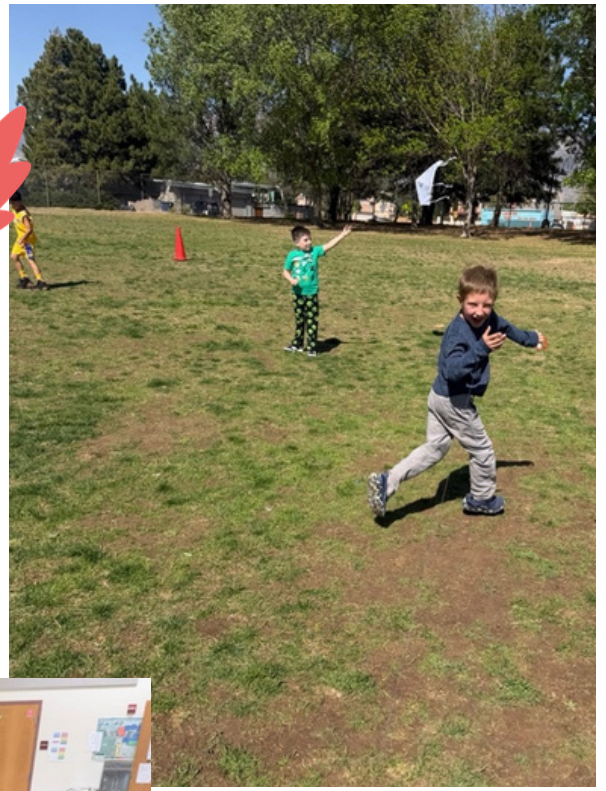
