Destination: Older Unit at The Sandia Peak Tramway

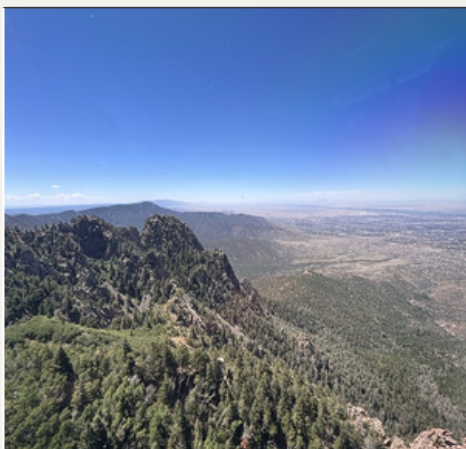
