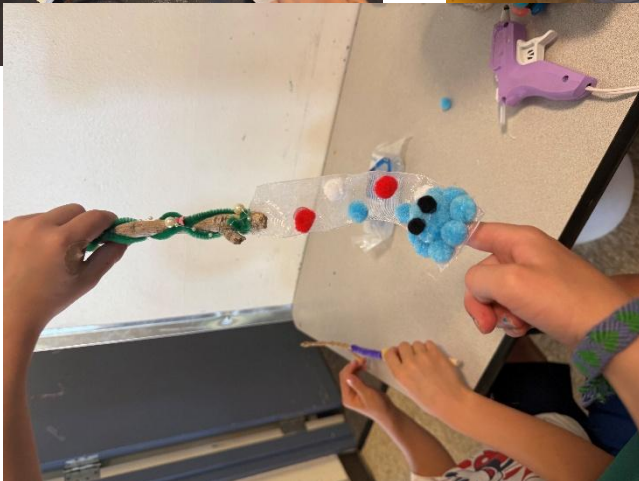

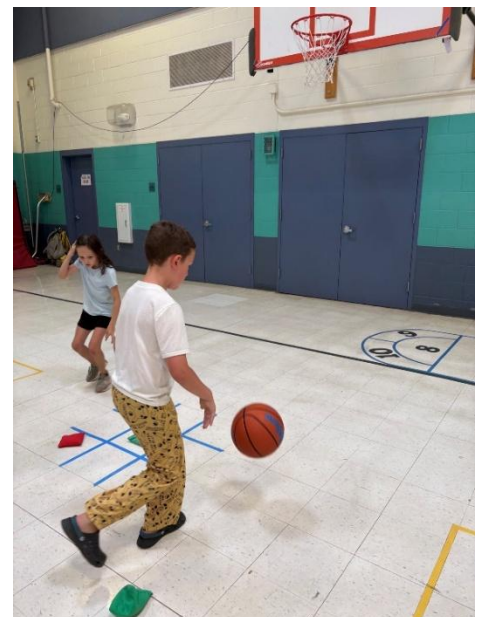
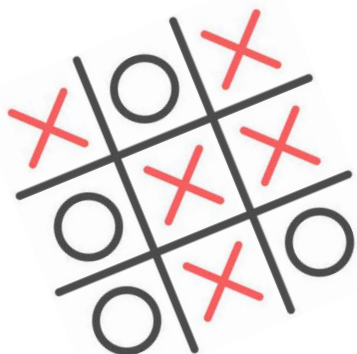
Magic in the Making
