Oobleck Buddies!

TODAY, WE EXPLORED THE SCIENCE BEHIND OOBLECK BEFORE MAKING OUR OWN OOBLECK STRESS BALLS. WE LEARNED THAT OOBLECK IS A NON-NEWTONIAN FLUID, WHICH MEANS IT CAN ACT LIKE A LIQUID OR A SOLID DEPENDING ON HOW MUCH FORCE IS APPLIED TO IT. THE CHILDREN ENJOYED EXPERIMENTING WITH THE OOBLECK BY TOUCHING, SQUEEZING, AND OBSERVING HOW IT CHANGED. AFTER WE USED THE OOBLECK TO CREATE STRESS BALLS BY FILLING BALLOONS AND SECURING THEM. THIS ACTIVITY ALLOWED THE CHILDREN TO LEARN ABOUT SCIENCE THROUGH HANDS ON EXPLORATION WHILE ALSO CREATING SOMETHING FUN THEY COULD USE TO SQUEEZE AND PLAY WITH.
