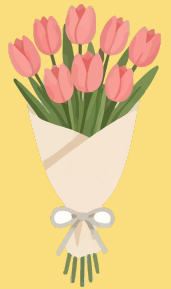

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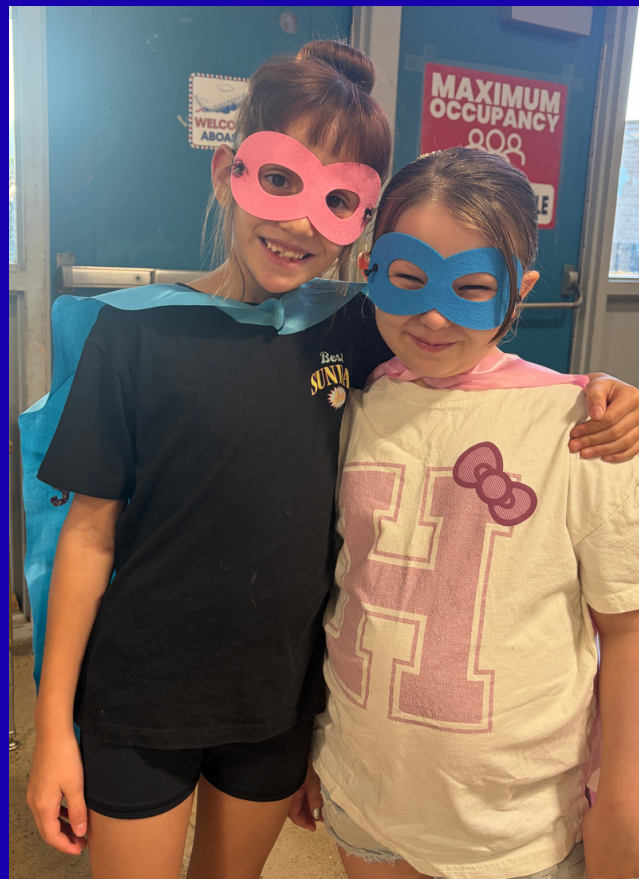
This year, we have two very special Super Helpers who have gone above and beyond to make Sombra feel like home for everyone: Luna and Cassidy!
